Doctor G. Anthony Slagel is your friend. 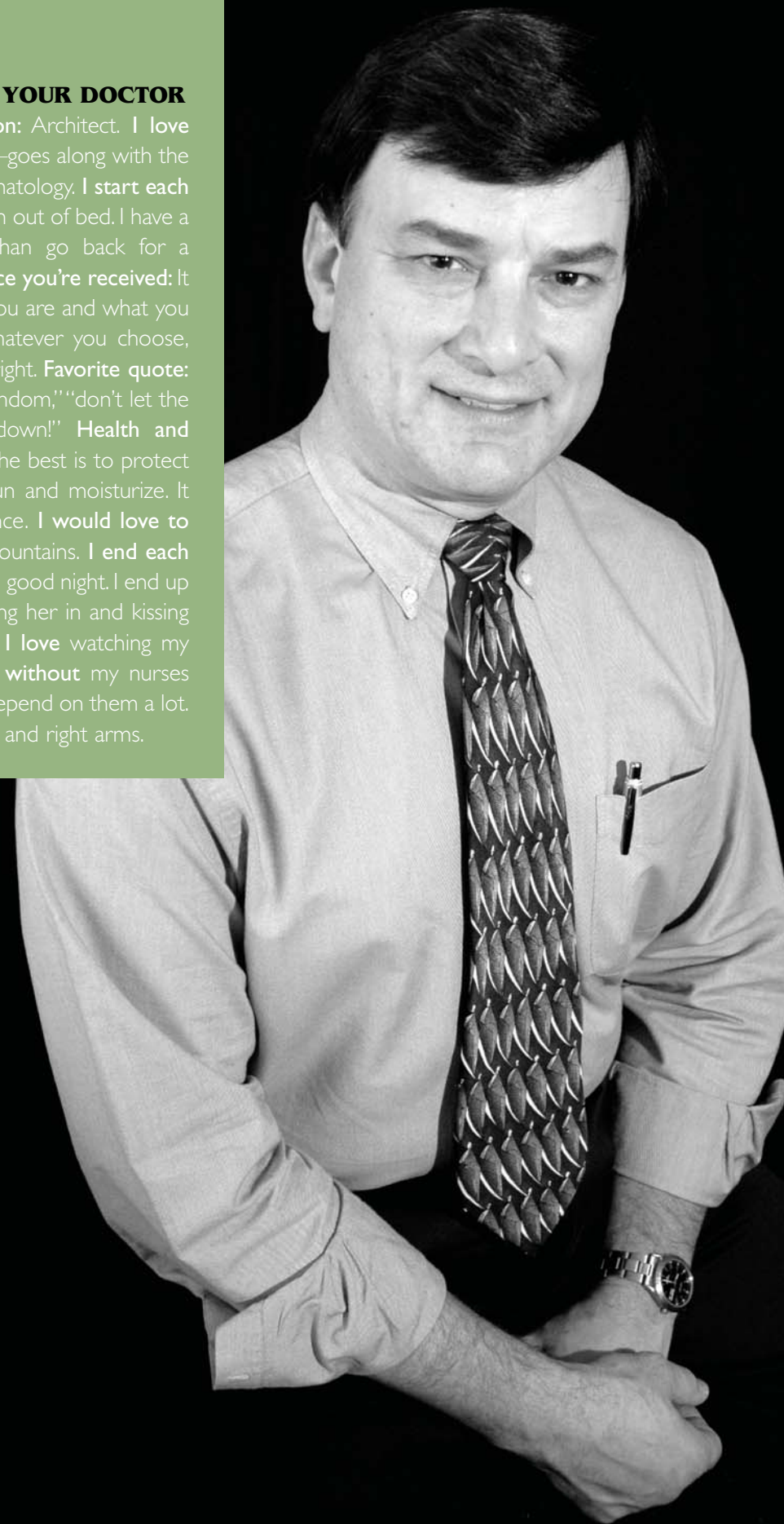
ing diligently to stay abreast of the changes to accommodate an aging baby boomer population that refuses to grow - and look - old, as well as a younger population that spent too much time in the sun or who have learned the importance of an early start to good skincare.

"Twenty years ago, when I was in my residency, we had one cosmetic product: collagen. That was it. Now we have a couple hundred products. When I was in my residency there may have existed two or three types of lasers, now we have over 70 to 80 types of lasers. And the big changes will continue to be cosmetics," says Dr. Slagel.

But Dr. Slagel's medicine moves beyond cosmetics. By practicing dermatology, internal diseases that manifest on the skin, such as cancer, Raynaud's phenomenon, lupus and acne, are also treated. "Dermatology is one of the few areas of medicine that combines surgical skills along with medical treatment. I get to practice medicine, but I also get to perform so many nice procedures that it combines the best of both surgery and medicine." And that leaves patients not only looking but feeling better with each visit. ■
